ETHICS IN THEORY AND PRACTICE ESSAY COMPETITION

Four awards of up to \$3000 are available to students with a demonstrated interest in questions of value and meaning in contemporary life. To qualify, students must be full-time with a 3.0 GPA in any UIC undergraduate college. The application will consist of a letter of recommendation from a current UIC faculty member; a transcript; and an essay that demonstrates an ability to think carefully and write clearly about perennial questions. You are asked to write an essay of no longer than 5 pages (in standard double-spaced format) on one of two questions. Make sure to argue your point with sufficient detail to demonstrate your understanding of the nuances of the question, and enough logic to indicate how carefully you can think about larger issues. This award is administered by the Honors College but is open to all full-time undergraduates.
